



## CONTRAINDICATIONS

Contraindications are something (such as a symptom or condition) that makes a particular treatment or procedure inadvisable aka possible deal-breakers.

**WE MUST KNOW BEFORE BOOKING YOUR APPOINTMENT** about any pre-existing conditions that could interfere with the consideration of the Microblading/Micropigmentation treatment. Failure to do so will forfeit your deposit and appointment. If in doubt disclose it and discuss it.

### **THE FOLLOWING WILL INTERFERE WITH CONSIDERATION FOR PERMANENT MAKEUP TREATMENT:**

1. ANY PREVIOUS COSMETIC TATTOOING...EVER! You will need to be assessed before booking.
2. **PHYSICIANS NOTE REQUIRED:** diabetes, high blood pressure, bleeding disorders, Blood Thinning Medications prescribed, circulatory disorders, currently diagnosed with skin cancer on any part of the body, Serious diseases such as cancer, epilepsy, autoimmune disorders, any skin diseases or irritation in the area.
3. **NOT A CANDIDATE:** Dark Hyperpigmentation, pregnancy/nursing, forms keloid scars
4. Scars under a year old in area of tattoo (not a candidate until after 1 year)
5. Acne medications such as: Retin-A, Differin or topical vitamin A, Accutane or solodyn; 6-12 months waiting period after last dose (**Physicians note required**)
6. Active Herpes Breakout (Cold Sores) ALL CLIENTS (can't schedule treatment for minimum of 4 wks after healed)
7. LIP BLUSH CLIENTS ONLY: History of cold sores you must do antiviral treatment pre & post treatment
8. Moles or birthmarks (review with photos)
9. Recent Botox or Fillers (must wait 2 months)
10. Sunburn (wait until fully healed + 3 additional weeks)
11. After Waxing or threading (must wait 1 wk)
12. After Chemical Peels (must wait 2-6 weeks depending on how abrasive the peel is; NO dry or peeling skin)
13. ANY skin issues past or present **EVER** must be disclosed as this can result in poor healing or pigment uptake.
